The policy promotes engagement and challenge for every student in every school across intellectual, creative, social-emotional and physical domains of potential, while explicitly identifying and addressing the learning needs of high potential and gifted students.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION 2025

Elizabeth Macarthur High School would like to offer talented Year 6 students in four fields, an opportunity to start in Year 7 with a financial and tuition boost. Scholarships are available in the four domains of High Potential and Gifted Education:



Social/Emotional (Leadership)

The social-emotional domain of potential refers to natural abilities in self-management and relating to and interacting with others.



Intellectual

The intellectual domain of potential refers to natural abilities in processing, understanding, reasoning and the transfer of learning.



Physical (Sport)

The physical domain of potential refers to natural abilities in muscular movement and motor control.



Creative

The creative domain of potential refers to natural abilities in imagination, invention and originality.

Successful applicants will receive a full school uniform with black leather shoes included and sports uniform, all subject fees for the year, and a \$30 Harry Hartog voucher.

The successful applicants will be considered by a panel including the Principal, the Year Advisers, the Head Teacher High Potential and Gifted Education, the President of the P & C and the Deputy Principal for Year 7, 2025 and informed by mail of this decision.

Students may apply for one or more scholarships but must make a separate application for each Scholarship they wish to apply for. Please make sure to identify which Scholarship you are applying for. The application must be written by the student in their own words.
